The SCHOOL of RICHMOND BALLET was founded in 1975 to provide the highest standard of avocational and pre-professional ballet training in Virginia. SCHOOL of RICHMOND BALLET is the official ballet training division of Richmond Ballet, the State Ballet of Virginia, and offers exceptional dance instruction for students of all ages, from beginner through professional levels.



The Lower Division

features three levels of ballet instruction for students beginning at age eight. Advancement through the Lower Division is based on a student's level of skill and accomplishment, not his or her age. The School's faculty evaluates and places each student in the appropriate level. Students in the Lower Division attend ballet classes that incorporate barre and center work twice weekly and have the option of adding jazz, character dance and/or theatre dance classes to enhance their training.

Dress Code

Lower Level Girls: (*Ballet*)

- Lower I and II: Light Blue short sleeve, scoop neck leotard
- Lower III: Burgundy short sleeve, scoop neck leotard
- Pink footed dance tights and pink ballet shoes with elastics

Lower Level Boys: (*Ballet*)

- Black ballet shoes (All Levels)
- White Socks
- White fitted t-shirt (All Levels)
- Black knit shorts (Lower I & II)
- Black dance tights with feet, worn with dance belt undergarment (Lower III)

Jazz & Theatre Dance

- Any color leotard, tights, or T-Shirt and Jazz pants
- Theatre Dance students wear red, white, and black only
- Black jazz shoes for all

Character Dance

- Boys & Girls: Ballet Attire
- Girls: Black Knee-Length Circular Skirt (not chiffon wrap-around)
- Boys: black jazz pants optional
- Black jazz shoes for all (girls may wear black, 1-inch character dance shoes if they would like)

Additional Information

- No split sole or canvas ballet shoes, leather only with elastics.
- No varied necklines, strings, halters, or low backs on leotards.
- No skirts, sweats, warmers, jewelry, or watches.
- No footless or rolled up tights in Ballet classes.
- Hair should be pulled back neatly from the face; in a ballet bun for girls.

General Policies

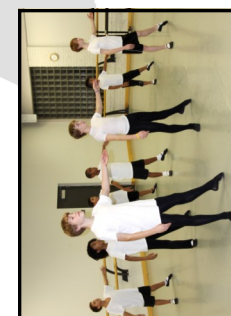
1. Parents are asked to please remain in the lobby and not outside the classrooms during class times, so that the student can focus his/her entire attention on dance. We have designated specific days when parents are invited into the classrooms to observe student progress.
2. The School is not responsible for lost or stolen personal property.
3. Since dance is a strenuous activity, the school suggests a complete physical prior to starting classes.
4. Students are not permitted to participate in a class after entering late without the permission of the instructor.
5. **Absences** should be reported to the teacher prior to the missed class at (804) 344-0906. Students are urged to make up any classes that are missed, in another class of the same level. Make-up classes must be completed within the session.
6. Students are not permitted outside of the Richmond Ballet building without street shoes on and clothes over dancewear.
7. Tuition is non-refundable except in the case of serious illness or injury with written verification from a physician. School of Richmond Ballet does not refund registration fees or deposits.
