The SCHOOL of RICHMOND BALLET was founded in 1975 to provide the highest standard of avocational and pre-professional ballet training in Virginia. SCHOOL of RICHMOND BALLET is the official ballet training division of Richmond Ballet, the State Ballet of Virginia, and offers exceptional dance instruction for students of all ages, from beginner through professional levels.



The Middle Division

features three levels of instruction, and offers a wide variety of classes designed to provide a more in-depth study of classical ballet technique. Advancement through the Middle Division is based on a student's level of skill and progress, not his or her age. The School's faculty evaluates and places each student in the appropriate level. Class offerings include ballet technique and pointe, jazz, theatre dance, and character dance. Middle Ballet students have performance opportunities with the SRB Ensembles and in Richmond Ballet company performances.

Dress Code

Middle Level Girls: *Ballet*

- Middle I: Burgundy Leotard in uniform styles (scoop neck, short or long sleeve, no camisole)
- Middle II and III: Navy Leotard in uniform styles (Scoop neck, short or long sleeves, no camisole)
- All Levels: Pink footed dance tights and pink ballet shoes with elastics
- Levels II and III,: Pink pointe shoes

Middle Level Boys: *Ballet*

- Black or white ballet shoes (All Levels)
- White fitted t-shirt (All Levels) must be tucked in
- Navy or Black footed Tights rolled on a belt
- White Socks optional

Character Dance

- Boys & Girls: Ballet Attire
- Girls: Black Knee-Length Circular Skirt (not chiffon wrap-arounds)
- Boys: black jazz pants optional
- Girls: Black Character Dance Shoes
- Boys: Black jazz shoes

Jazz & Theatre Dance

- Any color leotard, tights, or T-Shirt and Jazz pants
- Theatre Dance students wear red, white, and black only
- Black jazz shoes for jazz and theatre dance

Additional Information

- No split sole or canvas ballet shoes, leather only, with elastics. Pointe shoes must have ribbons
- No varied necklines, strings, halters, or low backs on leotards
- No skirts, sweats, warmers, jewelry, or watches
- No footless or rolled up tights in Ballet or Pointe classes
- Hair should be pulled back neatly from the face; in a ballet bun for girls

General Policies

1. Parents are asked to please remain in the lobby, not outside the classrooms, during class times, so that the student can focus his/her entire attention on dance. We have designated specific days when parents are invited into the classrooms to observe student progress.
2. The School is not responsible for lost or stolen personal property.
3. Since dance is a strenuous activity, the school suggests a complete physical prior to starting classes.
4. Students are not permitted to participate in a class after entering late without the permission of the instructor.
5. **Absences** should be reported to the teacher prior to the missed class at (804) 344-0906. Students are urged to make up any classes that are missed, either in the same level or below. Make up classes must be completed within the session.
6. Students are not permitted outside of the Richmond Ballet building without street shoes on and clothes over dancewear.
7. Tuition is non-refundable except in the case of serious illness or injury with written verification from a physician. The School of Richmond Ballet does not refund registration fees or deposits.
