Five, Six, & Seven Year Olds

BALLET CLASSES

Eight through Twelve Year Olds

The Lower Division features three levels of instruction for students ages eight through twelve. Advancement through the Lower Division is based on a student's level of skill and accomplishment, not his or her age. The School's faculty evaluates and places each student in the appropriate level.

Students in the Lower Division attend ballet classes that incorporate barre and center work twice weekly and have the option of adding jazz, modern, theatre dance and character dance classes.

Students of the School of Richmond Ballet will continue in their current level from spring semester unless otherwise instructed by faculty.

New students will be placed by SRB faculty.

Pink short sleeve, scoop neck leotard

*** Pre-Primary & Primary Ballet:**

Lavender short sleeve, scoop neck leotard

- * All levels --- Pink dance tights, or pink or white ankle socks, and pink leather ballet shoes

Lower Level Girls: Ballet

- * **Lower I and II: Light Blue** short or long sleeve, scoop neck leotard

- * **Lower III: Burgundy** short or long sleeve, scoop neck leotard

- * Pink dance tights and pink leather ballet shoes

Boys: (Ballet)

- * Black or White ballet shoes (All Levels)

- * White Socks

- * White fitted t-shirt (All Levels)

- * Black knit shorts for Lower I and II,
Black dance tights for Lower III.

Jazz, Modern & Theatre Dance

- * Any color leotard, tights, or T-Shirt and Jazz pants
(*Theatre Dance students wear red, white, and black only*)

- * Black jazz shoes for Jazz and Theatre Dance.
Bare feet for Modern.

Character Dance

- * Boys & Girls: Ballet Attire
Girls: Black Full-Length Circular Skirt
(not chiffon wrap-arounds)
Boys: may wear black jazz pants or dance tights.

Additional Information

- 1.No split sole or canvas ballet shoes, leather only.
- 2.No varied necklines, strings, halters, or low backs, or decoration on leotards.
3. No skirts, sweats, warmers, jewelry, or watches.
4. No footless or rolled up tights in Ballet classes.
5. Hair should be pulled back neatly from the face in a ballet bun (or ponytail for Children's Division). No loose hair around face.

General Policies

1. Parents are asked to please remain in the lobby during class times, so that the student can focus his/her entire attention on dance. We have designated specific days when parents are invited into the classrooms to observe student progress.
2. The School is not responsible for lost or stolen personal property. Please leave all valuables at home.
3. Since dance is a strenuous activity, the school suggests a complete physical prior to starting classes.
4. Students are not permitted to participate in a class after entering late without the permission of the instructor.
5. **Absences** should be reported prior to the missed class at (804) 344-0906 x 228. Students are urged to make up any classes that are missed. Make up classes must be completed within the session.
6. Students are not permitted outside of the Richmond Ballet building without full street clothes on over dancewear, and street shoes.
7. Tuition is non-refundable except in the case of serious illness or injury with written verification from a physician. The School of Richmond Ballet does not refund registration fees or deposits.
8. Classes are contingent upon meeting required enrollment numbers. The School of Richmond Ballet may cancel any classes not meeting enrollment requirements.
9. Students may bring non-breakable water bottles to class. Food and/or other beverages are allowed in designated snack areas only. No gum in SRB building.
